



## **NHRA NEW ENGLAND NATIONALS**

**WHAT:** **Ninth annual NHRA New England Nationals**, the eighth event of the NHRA Camping World Drag Racing Series 2022 season. Drivers in the professional categories – Top Fuel, Funny Car and Pro Stock will earn points leading to 2022 NHRA Camping World Drag Racing Series world championships. Competition also will be featured in the NHRA Lucas Oil Series.

**WHERE:** **New England Dragway**, Epping, N.H., the track is on Route 101 off Exit 8, an hour north of Boston and just 20 minutes from Manchester and the New Hampshire Sea coast. From I-95, take Exit 2 in New Hampshire. Travel west on Route 101 to Exit 8, then turn right. From I-93, take Exit 7 in New Hampshire. Travel east on Route 101 to Exit 8, then turn left, and the track is straight ahead. From I-495, take Exit 51-B to Route 125 north. Travel east on Route 101 to Exit 8, then turn left, and the track is straight ahead.
